REGION MEET POLICIES

1. Track meets, including the Region meet, will start at 3:30 pm.
2. The Region will provide the following awards:
 - a. Scoring for the region championships will be based on the NFHS rulebook for scoring to eight places in individual events, top six in relays.
 - b. Each school is allowed 5 competitors per event in the Region Championship Meet and one relay team.
3. In the Region Meet, all athletes must be in uniform according to NFHS rules. Exceptions to this due to extraordinary circumstances must be approved in advance by the Region Chair.
4. NFHS Rules will govern the Region Meet.
5. Region JV Entries become finalized at 6:00 a.m. May 16 the day of the meet.
6. Once paged to an event, a participant has a maximum of 10 minutes to report to the event site. Failure to report within the time limit will result in disqualification.
7. **GAMES COMMITTEE** – the games committee consists of one coach representative from each school, Track activity chairs, head finish judge and starter. If an issue arises there will be a vote. The decision will be determined by the majority.

FIELD EVENT ASSIGNMENTS:

NOTE - Each school will be required to bring two adults and two student-athletes to help run their respective event at the meet. Schools should arrive with the pertinent section of the rule book in hand to run their event.

LEAVING AN EVENT TO PARTICPATE IN ANOTHER EVENT

“To accommodate those competitors who may be excused to participate in other events, the head judge may change the order of competition in preliminary or final rounds of any throwing event by any method. Successive trials is but one such method. Excused competitors shall inform the head event judge upon their return. The competitor with the best mark in the preliminaries has earned the right to make the last attempt of the competition and may choose to wait until after any excused competitors have taken all their trials.”

“Time limits for competitors excused to compete in another event shall be determined by the games committee.”

“In the vertical jumps, before the crossbar is raised, the judge will pass an excused competitor who has not returned within the designated time limit.”

“After competition has started, the bar shall not be lowered, except to determine a first-place winner when a tie for that place is involved.”

Electronic Devices -

“Video replay or television monitoring equipment, other than the official finish line equipment approved by the games committee prior to the start of competition, shall not be used to make decisions related to the meet. Use of wireless communication devices, official communication equipment, is allowed.”

“a. Electronic devices shall not be used to transmit information to the competitor during the race or trial.

b. Electronic devices shall not be used for any review of an official’s decision”
